0 – The Fool

Strain: Maui Wowie

Flavor Profile: Pineapple, mango, tropical citrus

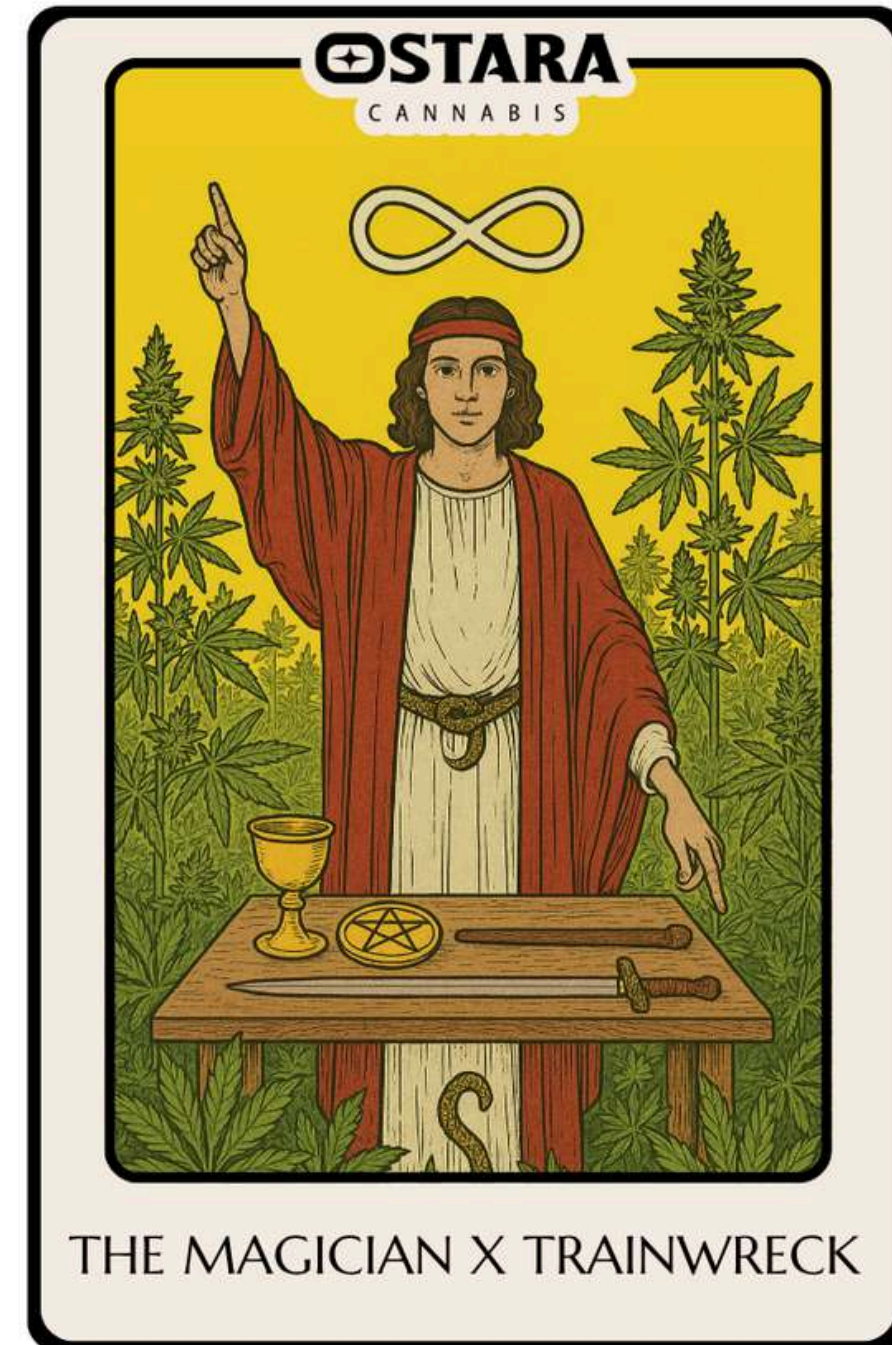
